HOW TO BECOME A BANKRUPTCY CLIENT OF KORB TUCKER PLLC

Before we can give you specific legal advice, please complete these steps:

- (1) Fill out and submit our Online Inquiry Form. The information you provide to us will help us discuss your options with you.
- (2) Read the three Bankruptcy Initial Notices. We are required by the Bankruptcy Code to give you the notices and disclosures contained in these documents. Their purpose is to tell you about your duties under the strict requirements of the Bankruptcy Code.
- (3) Sign and date the Acknowledgements at the end of each of the three Bankruptcy Initial Notices, and send them to us.
- (4) Schedule your Bankruptcy Initial Consultation with us.
- (5) Attend your Initial Consultation, which will be 30 to 45 minutes in length. One of our attorneys will talk to you about your circumstances and options (both bankruptcy and non-bankruptcy), the services we can provide, and the fees we would charge for our services. You won't be billed separately for this consultation – it is included in the fee that you pay once you decide to engage the firm to represent you.
- (6) Read, sign, and return the firm's Engagement Agreement, and pay the fees requested by cash or check. *We cannot accept credit card payments.*

Once you become a client of the firm, your attorney will give you further details about what we need to prepare and file your bankruptcy petition.
